### **ACADEMICS (2018-19)**

I wish to begin with our performance on the academic front. Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of our Endeavour as educators. Academic achievements reflect a demonstrated ability to perform to the best of one's ability by developing one's intellectual potentials and skills with diligence and ardor. We are happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students of Classes X to XII.

- **In Class XII, Yash Chopra** secured first position by getting 92.8% in Commerce stream. Whereas **Geetanjali** with 90.8% secured Second & **Jaanvi Sembhi** third Position with 84.8%.
- In Science stream **Riya Arora** secured first Position by getting 89%, **second position by** Jannatdeep Chahal (84.8%) & **3<sup>rd</sup> position by** Amanpreet Kaur (84.6% ).
- In Arts stream, Jagvir singh secured first position, Baljinder Singh second and Karamjit Singh Atwal third position.
  
- **In Class X, Yachana Sharma** secured first position with **94%**, **Aastha** secured Second position with 91.4% and **Arshpreet Singh Mahey** third position with **88.8%**

## **SPORTS**

Sports, Games and Physical Fitness occupy a place of importance in our curriculum. We host DAV National Sports- Kho-Kho Cluster Level Tournament every year. 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## **SCHOOL HOUSES**

The students of the school are divided into four different houses Swami Dayanand Ji, M. Hanshraj Ji, S. Virjanand Ji and Anand Swami Ji. Each House is managed by Teachers and Students. The House on duty performs its duty of conducting the day-to-day activities, competitions in systematic and disciplined manner.

*In month of December we organized sports day*

*From many years, parents and guardians of school children were demanding to make passage. So keeping it in mind and to make safe dispersal and school coming of school children, we constructed passage with interlocking tiles that connects entrance of school with the main building.*

- **Construction of Walls :** *To make school campus more secure and safe, two walls constructed along with gates on the both side of Sh. Shadi Ram Bhuchar Block.*
- **Footpath:** *A Interlocking Tiles Footpath was constructed, which connects outside gate to school buildings.*
- **To make school campus more healthy and hygienic a septic tank and soakage pit were constructed to store waste water in the backside of old building.**

- **Construction of New Washrooms:** *There were no washrooms in Sh. Sahdi Ram Bhuchar Block, so we constructed 4 new washrooms in the block 2 for girls and 2 for boys. We also constructed 5 new washrooms in Smt. Atma Devi block.*
- **Electrical Work:** *we completed electric work of wiring, installation of switches and electrical appliances in Shadi Ram Bhuchar block which was pending from many years.*
- *We renovated stair of old building. Whole admin block was renovated by installing tiles and whitewash.*
- **New Classroom Construction:**  
*Due to shortage of classrooms, we constructed two new classrooms in this session in Smt. Atma Devi Block and six new classrooms are under construction.*
  - *White wash work of both buildings has been done in this session.*
  - *There was a problem of water leakage in the terrace of Shadi Ram Bhuchar block so to protect it, we made it waterproof by installing tiles.*

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- **Prabhjeet Singh** std of XII showed his excellence in Athletics in DAV NATIONAL SPORTS AND CBSE ATHELETICS. At National Level of DAV Sports , he bagged 2 Silver Medals in 400 mtr & Relay Race. And 3 Gold medals at State level in 400,800 & Relay race.
